#### Specialist classrooms.


At St. John's you will be able to have some lessons in classrooms especially designed for that subject, including;

Every pupil is given a planner to keep with them in school.

It is like a homework diary or reading record and helps you to know which lessons you have each day, it is for writing in messages to teachers and for writing down any homework you might have.
