



# A quick guide to behaviour for learning and building positive relationships

# Expectation points

- ▶ For every lesson that you do not receive any demerit points, you receive an expectation point.
- ▶ For going above and beyond you can receive additional points.
- ▶ The amount of points you require to request to go on the GOYB trip (cinema after Christmas) will be based on receiving at least 96% of your expectation points.
- ▶ If you do not get an expectation point in one lesson you will need to work hard and answer questions to try and recover the points needed.

# C1

We have our classroom 5 Golden rules (Displayed in all classrooms) to ensure that learning takes place and people feel safe and valued.

- ▶ The C1 is a warning.
- ▶ It is recorded as 1 demerit point.
- ▶ Teachers will remind you of the expectations and give you appropriate time to make the right choice. If you do not, you will receive a C1.
- ▶ If you respond positively, your teacher may award a point later in the lesson for self management. This would reward making a better choice (Reconciliation and Forgiveness)

# C2

- ▶ If you are asked to move to another seat to work so you can focus, following a warning, the teacher will record this on Epraise as a C2.
- ▶ If the teacher feels that you are getting too many of these in a particular lesson or over a short period of time, they will make contact with your parent/guardian. This is monitored by the Head of Year.

# C3

- ▶ If, following being moved, you continue to disrupt the learning or create an unsafe environment, a member of the behaviour recovery team will be called.
- ▶ If this happens, the teacher will record this on epraise as a C3 and send a message to your parent/guardian explaining what happened.
- ▶ If they do not receive a reply, they will phone and discuss what happened.

# Following Behaviour Recovery

- ▶ Behaviour recovery is about putting things right and avoiding a repeat or the situation getting worse.
- ▶ If you return to the class following behaviour recovery and learning or safety continue to be affected, you will receive a C4 (30 Minute after school intervention) and be removed for the remainder of the lesson.
- ▶ If you receive two C3s in a week, you will receive a 30 minute after school intervention.

# Leaving the classroom

- ▶ If you leave the classroom without permission we cannot ensure that you are safe and you are no longer learning.
- ▶ Anyone who leaves a class without permission will receive a C3 and parents/guardians will be notified by the teacher.

# Moral Compass

- ▶ Remember, we do the right thing because we know it is the right thing to do, not because someone is watching. This allows us to build positive relationships with one another.
