Vaccination of healthy children and young people aged 12-15

As you may be aware, individuals aged 12 to 15 in England will be offered one dose of the Pfizer/BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine, following advice from the 4 UK Chief Medical Officers (CMOs). The NHS is preparing to deliver a schools-based vaccination programme and in Worcestershire we are also able to offer vaccination via our local GP groups - Primary Care Networks (PCNs).

Each school will agree a date with the in-school provider, which in most cases will be SW Healthcare working with Vaccination UK and some PCNs who are able to offer an in-school service. A number of these dates will be after half term but to support an earlier offer of vaccination the PCNs will run clinics to which children will be invited. This invitation may be from their registered GP practice or one of the other practices in the PCN that is running the vaccination clinic.

You will be contacted nearer to the time of the school session to collect consent from you for any children who are eligible but who have not yet received the vaccine at another location.
