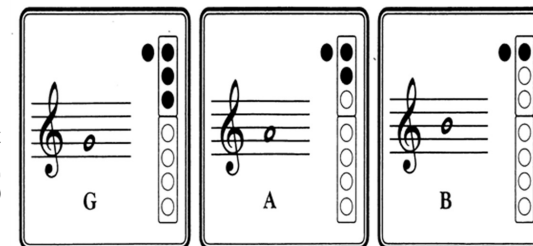

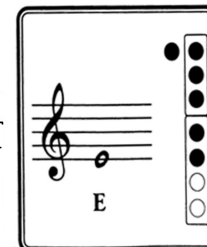

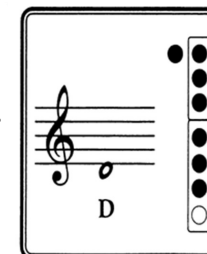

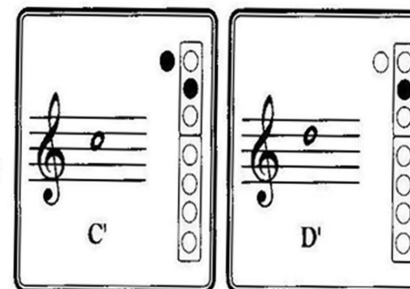
GREEN BELT



PURPLE BELT



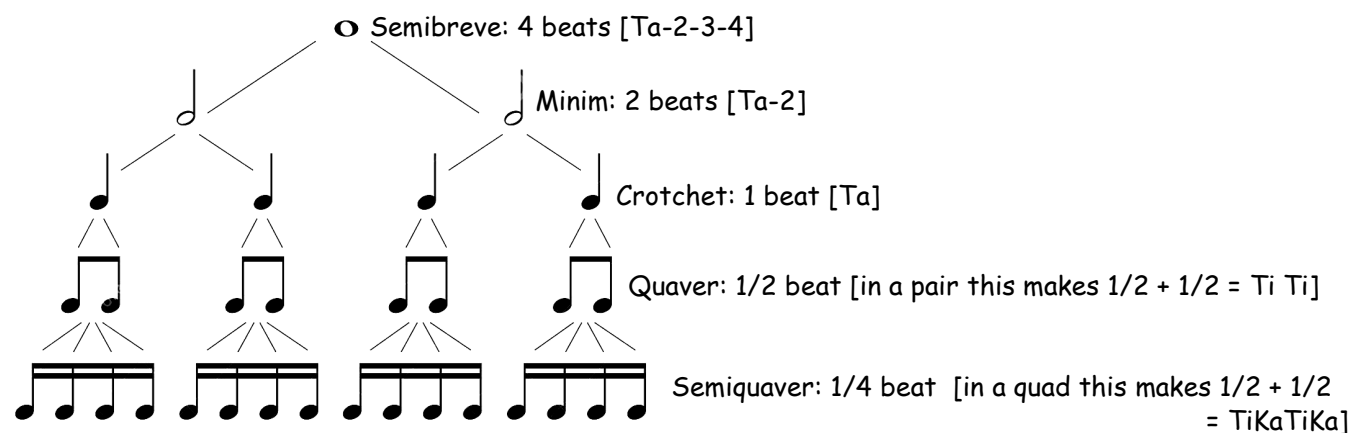

HOW TO PRACTICE EFFECTIVELY

- ⇒ Take your time, focus on the bits you find most tricky
- ⇒ Play the tricky bits over and over again until they are correct, then go back to the full piece
- ⇒ Stay on task and try to avoid distractions
- ⇒ If you get stuck remember: use this knowledge organiser and try to work it out, then ask other pupils and then ask the teacher for help
