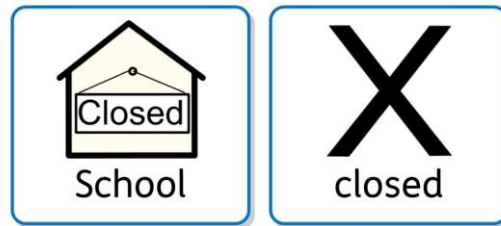


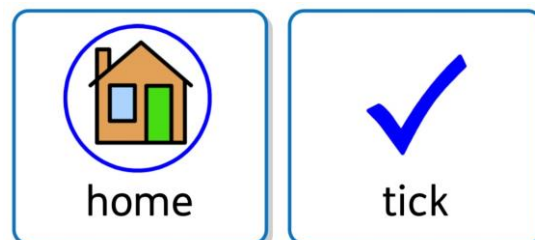
You will be coming back to St. John's soon



Since 23rd March 2020, most schools in England have closed to most of the children. It has been closed because of Coronavirus.

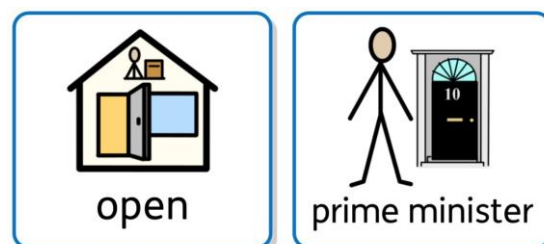


Some children still went to school each day because they have parents who work as key workers. Other children have been at home each day.



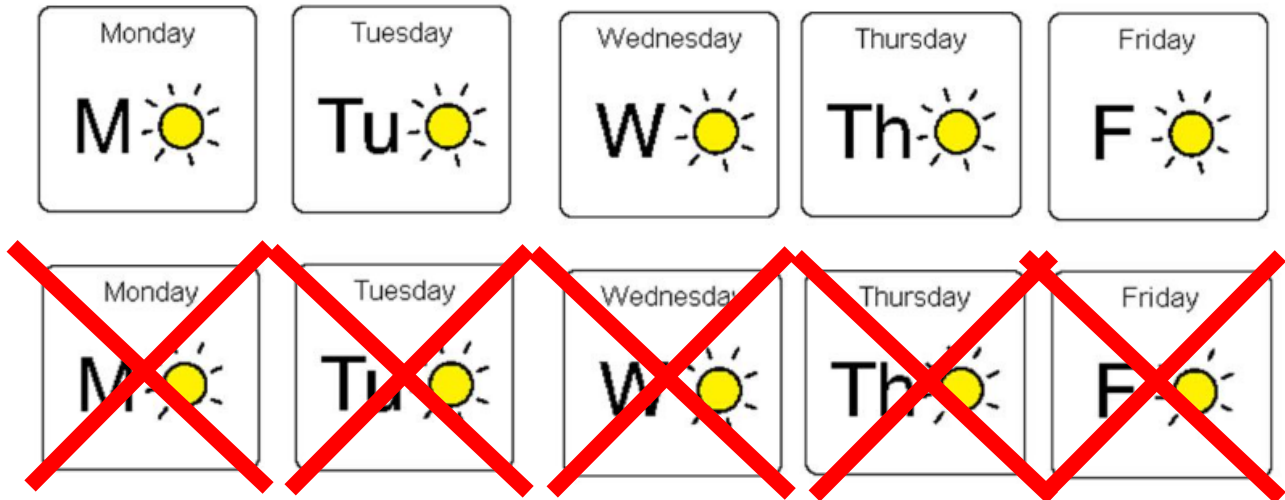
This time in lockdown has become a new normal for us all.
