Rocks and glaciation	Describe and explain different rock types and the rock cycle.
	Describe how rocks are eroded and weathered by different forces/agents.
	Understand the importance of soils and their structure.
	Describe what the Ice Age would have been like in Britain.
	Describe and explain the formation, location, processes and subsequent landforms associated with glaciation.

KPI	Milestone
Population and urbanisation	Identify, describe and explain the growth and pattern of global population and also UK population.
	Describe and explain weather and climate including how climate graphs present data.
	Explain how we measure population and what causes them to change over time. Use of graphical data, maps and statistics.
	Comparing world cities.
	Define and evaluate migration.
	Understand the problems associated with urbanisation in the UK and around the world. Focus on Rio de Janeiro as a case study.

KPI	Milestone
Development	Identify what development is, describing what some of the development indicators are.
	Understand the differing levels of development around the world with awareness of the historical north/south divide. Exploring how technology and rate of development is so much faster now.
	Identifying the differing levels of development in India - specifically Mumbai and the slums of Dharavi. Use of a variety of skills to explore this.
	Identifying how situations can be improved for people living in the developing world.
