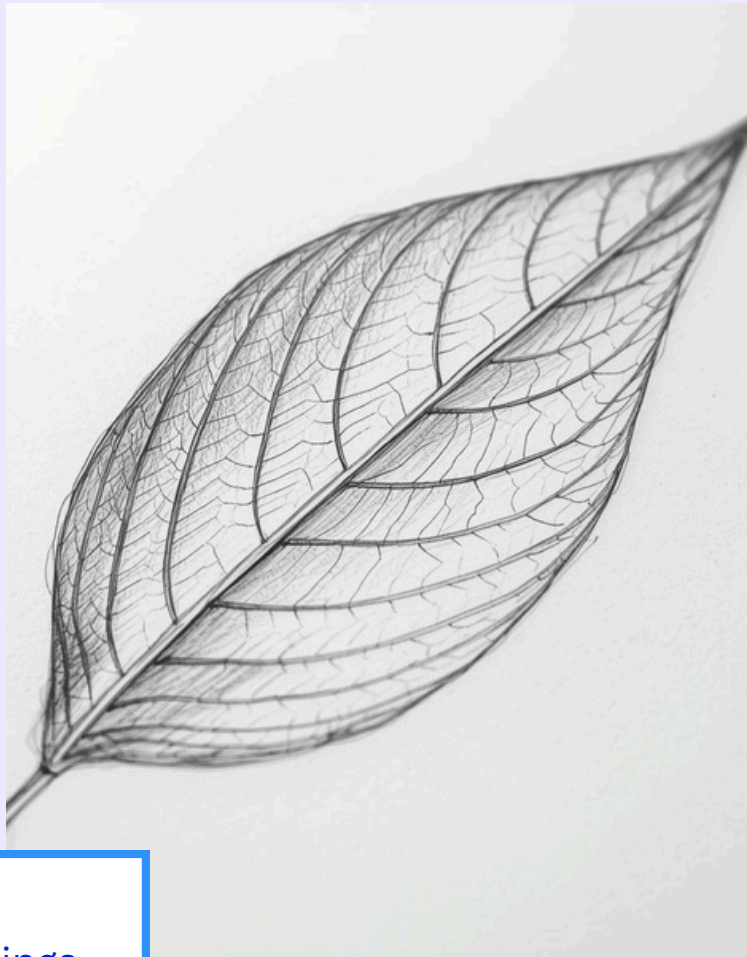

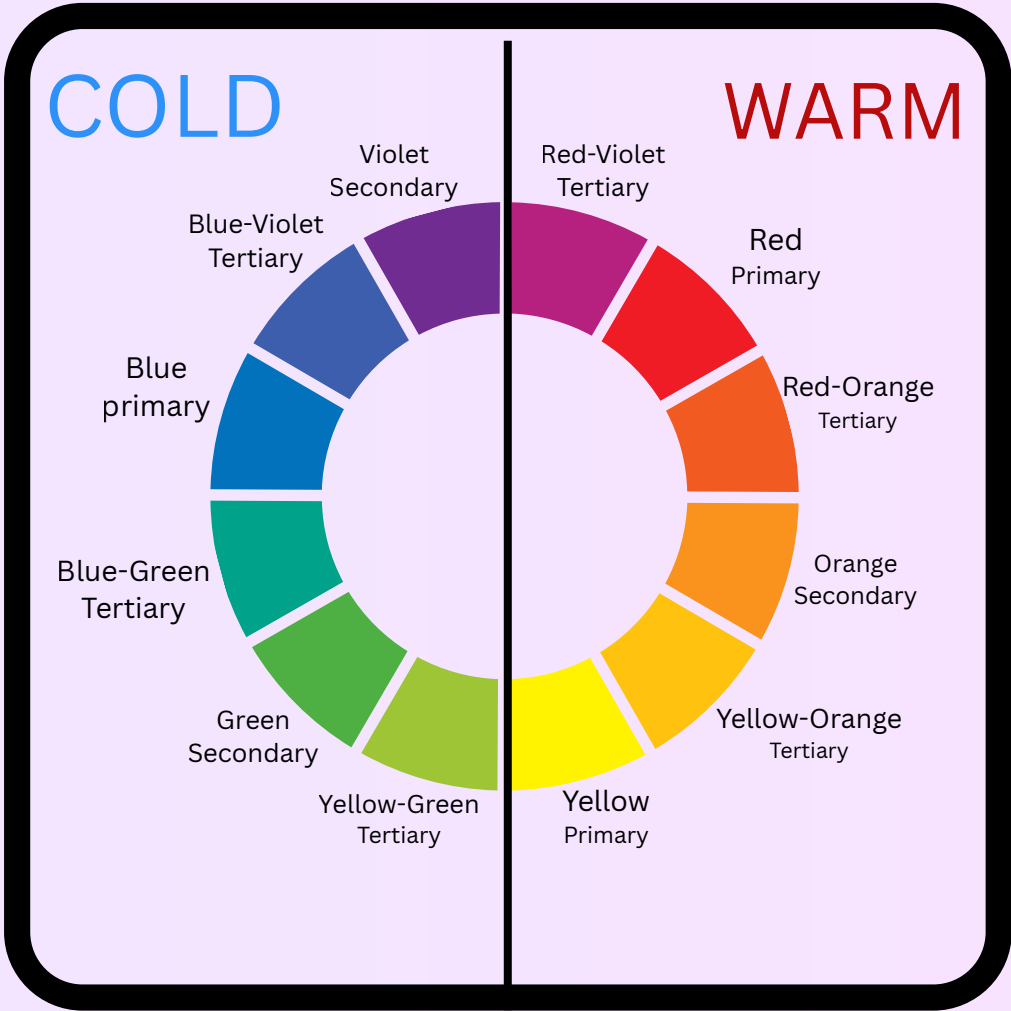
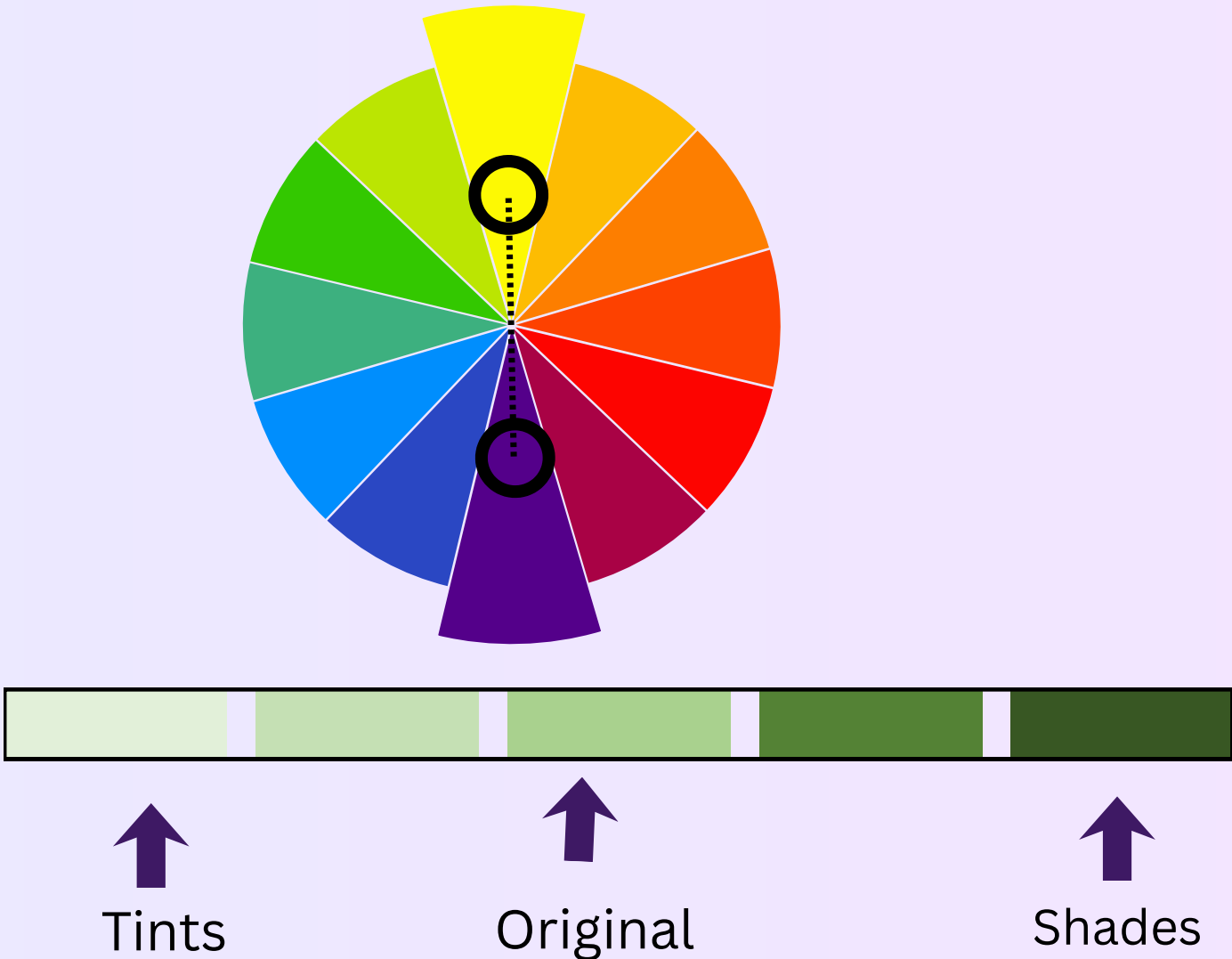


**Vocabulary Bank:**
