Year 7 Spring 2: If God is Trinity, what does this mean for Christians?

Theology = this is about 'believing'.

It looks at where beliefs come from,
how they have changed over time, how
they are applied in different contexts
and how they relate to each other.

Key vocabulary

Ascension = To rise; when Jesus ascended into Heaven after His resurrection

Creed = A statement of belief

Empowering = To become stronger & more confident

Monotheistic = To believe in ONE God

Pentecost = Festival celebrating the descent of the Holy Spirit to Jesus' disciples


Trinity = ONE God in 3 persons

Transcendent = Beyond human understanding

Resurrection = To rise from the dead

The term 'Trinity' is an *attempt to make sense* of the way the Bible describes God as being present in three ways, or being indivisible persons in one being. We can attempt to describe God using *analogies*, *symbols and metaphors* but God is <u>transcendent</u> and, therefore, beyond any human capacity to grasp in words. The Trinity is one such attempt.
