Knowing about and understanding religions and world views
I know that Christians believe God is omnipotent, omniscient and eternal and that means God is worth worshipping.
I can identify some different biblical texts using technical words accurately.
I know that Christians believe that Jesus is God in the flesh.
I can explain the place of incarnation and Messiah within the 'Big story' of the Bible.
I can explore and reflect on Abraham's trust in God.
I know how Moses received the Ten Commandments and what each Commandment means.
I can make connections between Muslim practice of the Five Pillars and their beliefs about God and the prophet Muhammad.
Expressing and communicating ideas related to religions and world views
I can explain connections between biblical texts and Christian ideas of God.
I can make connections between Bible texts and what Christians believe about God ; for example, through how churches are designed.
I can show how Christians put their beliefs about Jesus' Incarnation into practice in different ways in celebrating Christmas.
I can describe the forms of guidance a Muslim uses and compare these to guidance experienced by myself and pupils in my class.
Gaining and deploying the skills for studying religions and worldviews
I can weigh up how biblical ideas and teachings about God as holy and loving might make a difference in the world today.
I can weigh up how far the idea that Jesus is the Messiah – a Saviour from God- is important in the world today and, if it is true, what difference that might make in people's lives.
I can describe the impact that the belief that we have a soul might have on the way someone lives their life.
I can comment on the value and purpose of religious practices in a Muslim's daily life.
