It is a good idea to make a copy of this to keep at home.

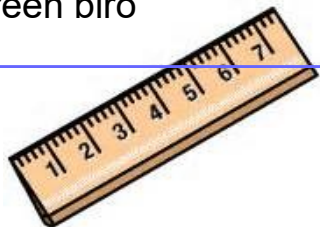
## What I should have in my pencil case.
