Knowing about and understanding religions and world views
I can explain what Christians mean by talking about God as Father, Son and Holy Spirit, using evidence from several Bible texts.
I can explain how the Bible uses metaphor, simile and analogy to help describe the different aspects of God.
I can formulate an account of how happiness could be derived from God.
I can consider and weigh up arguments equating happiness with the end of craving.
I know what the days of Holy Week are and why they are important to Christians.
I can appreciate what is good about being a teenage Sikh in Britain today and appraise what challenges are involved.
I can explain how ancient spiritual practices still sustain believers.
Expressing and communicating ideas related to religions and world views
I can give examples of how the Christian community respond to the idea of God as Trinity. For example, in expressing ideas about God through art, symbols and services.
I can weigh up the value of action in contributing to happiness.
Gaining and deploying the skills for studying religions and worldviews
I can evaluate my learning and express a view: Why do Christians worship God as Trinity and what difference does belief in God as Trinity make to them?
I can analyse non- religious values and offer an account of 'secular happiness.'
I can investigate what Sikh teenagers say about Western values and express my own views on this.
