## Outreach Support

**EIFS** – **Early Intervention Family Support and the parenting service** offer drop in sessions for parents and run groups in school with a focus on emotional wellbeing. EIFS workers also offer 1-1 work with children and their families.

**TFS** – **Targeted Family Support** will work directly with families who request additional support for more complex needs.

**Educational Psychologist** will come into school to provide support and guidance for staff and parents as well as children 1-1.

**Chadsgrove** offer support from the Complex Communication Needs Team and Learning Support Team

**CAMHS** can support children who are in need of support for mental health needs. **CAMHS CAST** workers provide outreach support to schools and parents/carers

There are **strong links and transition activities with our feeder first schools and with the high schools** when children leave St John's at the end of Year 8

There are positive links with the **local community police** and local community **housing trust** - **BDHT**

The **school nurse** offers access to NHS professionals such as Occupational Therapists and the Speech and Language Team as well as advice and support to parents/carers.
